PLEASE READ THIS OUT VERY LOUDLY ABOUT EXCENT TIMES TO YOUR MANIAC DRIVER !!!!

The National Topographic Map of this area advises that the general terrain in this region is renowned for vicious, hungry and abundant STUMPS. They willingly attack any car that wanders more than several inches off line. There are also a lot of puddles and splashes with muddy bits that can throw you off-line very easily. Some corners have surface changes half way around them just to keep your hearts beating at 180+ per minute.

Today's GEORGE DERRICK MEMORIAL TRIAL is designed to be a demanding test of the Drivers and Navigators ability under widely differing conditions. Any driver competing today who charges through the forest like it's a speedway track will have his/her pride suitably shattered and their cheque book emptied QUICK smart. It's not possible to caution **EVERY** sinister looking stump/gutter/rut/crest along the rally route. To do so would take about 2500 extra signs and another 450 pages of Route Instructions.
