Round 6 Victorian Rally Championship



Further Instructions / Regulations

The BLCC has accepted entries as shown in the attached entry list (Attachment 1) with provisional start order and times.

Competitors are requested to check entry list details and advise Event Secretary, Rod Hall on 0438313546 of any errors, particularly relating to nominations for points in any Championship/Series.

1. Event Start

The event will start and finish at the Ballarat Light Car Club clubrooms shown on the attached locality map (Attachment 2).

The start control TC0 is shown on the attached detailed map of the Service Park (Attachment 3). Competitors are requested to not line up at the start until 10 minutes before their starting time due to the limited space. Competitors must present ready to start at their starting time to be posted at Rally HQ at 0815 Sunday 15 November.

2. Rally Headquarters

Rally Headquarters will be in the BLCC Clubroom at the Ballarat Airport...

Rally HQ will be open on:

Friday 11 November from 1930 - 2100 hrs.

Saturday 12 November from 0800hrs to 11000hrs and from 1500hrs to 1700hrs.

Sunday 13 November from 0730hrs to 1900hrs.

3. Scrutiny

Official scrutiny will be held at:

Times: 17:30 to 19:30 (latest report time is 19:15)

Competitors who decide to change their scrutiny from Official to Regional or vice-versa must advise the Event Secretary Rod Hall on 0438 313 546 at the latest by 1700 hrs on Wednesday 9 November 2016.

Cars must be presented at scrutiny in a clean, tidy and 'ready to run' condition (including underbody). Rally tyres are not required to be fitted for scrutineering.

Vehicles which do not attend official scrutiny may be subject to an inspection by the Chief Scrutineer of the event before they can start.

Crews applying for regional scrutiny should note that there will be no provision at the event for turbo sealing; this will only be done at official scrutiny. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that vehicles that require turbochargers to be sealed have the turbochargers measured and sealed by an appropriately qualified Scrutineer.

4. Documentation and Book In

Documentation and Book in will be conducted as per Supplementary Regulations at Official Scrutiny and before the event at Rally HQ as per schedule above.

A member of the competing crew is required to report to the Event Secretary at Rally HQ prior to the event start and submit the whole scrutiny sheet (if not completed at Scrutiny).

5. Odometer Check

The organizer's odometer read 5.01km on the Sunraysia Highway north west of its split from the Western Freeway M8 from the 122-post located just after a large "B220" sign to the 127-post located just after "Historical Marker 300m on right" sign. This is also on the liaison stage between SS1 and SS2.

6. Recce Registration & Conduct

Registration for Recce must be completed prior to commencing Recce. Registration will take place at Rally HQ as per the open hours above. A Recce Registration Form is attached (Attachment 4).

A Recce road card and vehicle number will be provided. The number must be affixed to the upper left hand corner of the front Windscreen & upper right back window for the entire duration of Recce.

The Recce Road Card must be carried always and presented to event officials upon request for marking. If no official is present, competitors must fill in the time you commenced and finished each stage.

A maximum of 2 (two) passes of any stage will be allowed.

A maximum speed limit of 60km/h will be enforced on stages during recce.

It is suggested that SS2/7 and SS3/8 are done consecutively, and that SS4/9 and SS5/10 are done consecutively as it is only 5.2km from end of SS5/10 back to the start of SS4/9.

7. RallySafe Pick up

Rally Safe GPS tracking unit screens will be available for pick up from Rally HQ from 1500-1700 on Saturday 14 November and from 0700—0800 on Sunday 15 November.

8. Crew Briefing

The compulsory crew briefing will be held at Rally HQ, Ballarat Light Car Club Clubrooms at 1730, Saturday 12th of November.

9. Road Book

The course for Heat 1 and 2 is identical so it is not repeated in the Road book to save on paper.

A 20-minute service will be provided during both heats. A 40-minute service will be provided before the end of heat 1 at the BLCC Clubrooms. No other servicing is permitted. Refueling can only occur in the Refuel Zone located immediately after the exit from the start and service out. Five minutes is allowed for refueling each time in the liaison stages leaving BLCC Clubrooms.

There are no optional remote refuel opportunities.

Fuel is available in Ballarat & Wendouree, at various locations

It is necessary for all service crew personnel to sign a Disclaimer Form during Documentation or Book in periods at Rally HQ before the event to be covered by CAMS Personal Accident Insurance and to minimise their own liability.

13. Spectator Instructions

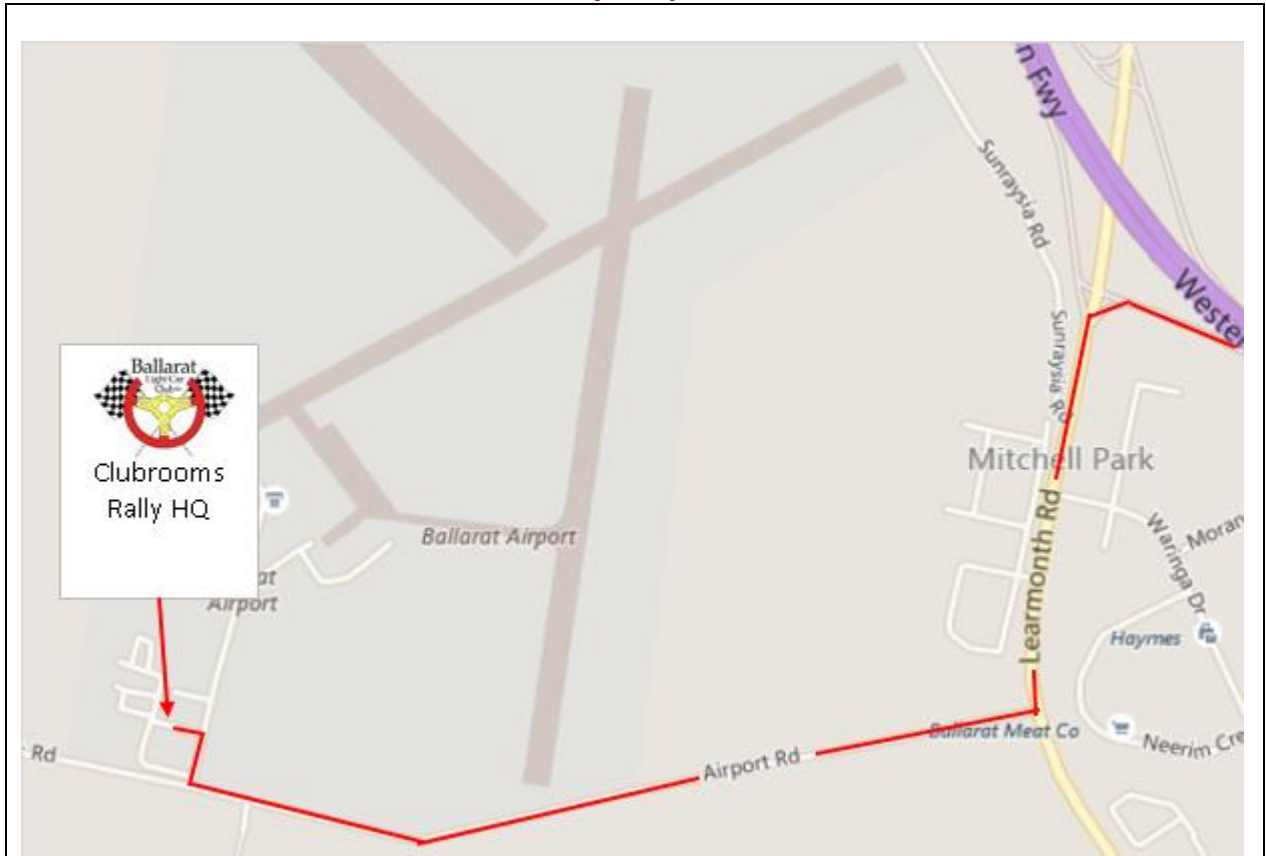

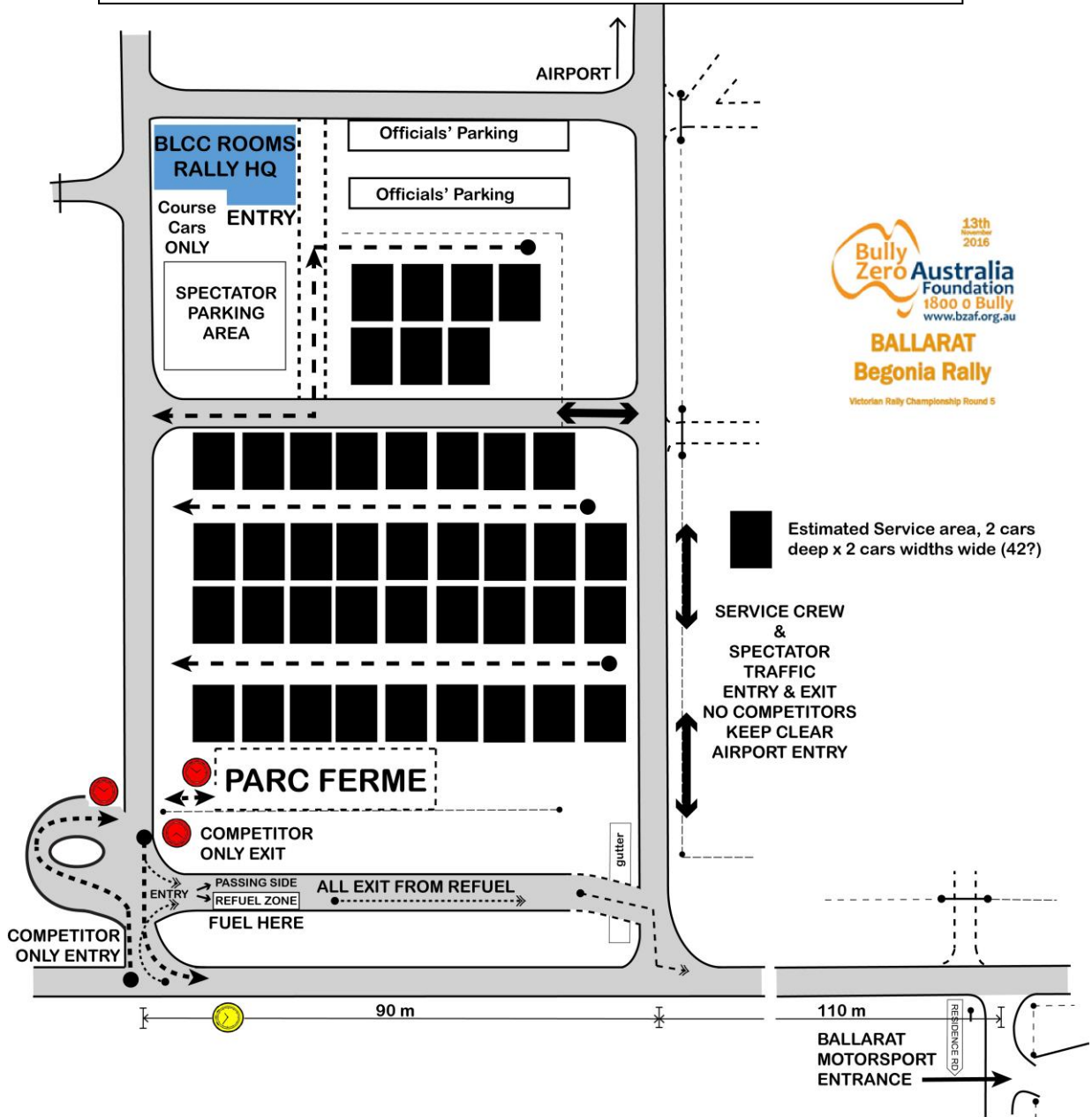
