FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Competitor,

Thank you for your entry in the event which has been accepted provisionally.

You will compete in GRADE 34.....

Your Starting Number is 23.....

Your due starting time is 7.44 p.m. Saturday, October 6th, 1979. 7.00

You are to report not later than 30 minutes prior to your starting time to the Control Official (penalty for late arrival is 2 points/minute).

On booking in at the Rally start you must hand your Scrutiny slip to the Control Official, who will supply you with:

1. Car numbers which must be fixed to both front doors of your car.
2. The Budget sticker (see Special Stage Awards).
3. Service Crew Instructions and Service Vehicle identification.
4. Two Dinner tickets.

Two minutes before your starting time, the official will hand you your Road Card and Route Instructions for the event.

START Will be at the 24-hour Shell Service Station in Benalla. The Service Station is approximately 1 km. past the Midland Highway turn-off, on the right-hand side of the Hume Highway when travelling from Melbourne.

Service Crews will be directed by their Instructions, but official maps would be useful if recovery is required.

Finish

RUNNING DETAILS

Should read, the event will start in Benalla and finish in the Benalla area and will consist of one (1) division of approximately 250 km. The event will be run during the hours of darkness.

Fuel will be available at the half-way point.

PENALTIES

Second paragraph Supp. Regs. should read, Time penalties will be expressed in minutes and seconds - 1 point/minute and 1/60th point per second.

ODOMETER CHECK

On the Hume Highway travelling North between the 180 km post and the 190 km. post the Director's Halda read 10.06 km.
This is just South of Benalla.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. In the Route Instructions the following abbreviations are used in addition to those noted in the C.A.M.S. Rally Handbook.

K.T.M.R. Keep to Main Road
K.T.M.T. " " " Track
M.R. Main Road
M.T. " Track
F.M.G. Follow Main Gravel.
P.P.C. Possible Passage Control.

NOTE: This may be either:

- a) Manned with a 'P' board displayed.
b) Not manned but Information required.
The Information will be preceded by a 'P' board.

2. There will be food available free of charge for the crews of competing vehicles at the Finish. This will be issued on the production of the two tickets issued to crews at the start of the event.
Food can be purchased at the finish by other people.
3. Competitors who withdraw are requested to hand in their Road Cards to a Control Official, with WITHDRAWN written across it.

QUIET ZONES

The maximum speed in a "Quiet Zone" is 60 km/hr. and lights must be dipped. Please obey this instruction. Failure to comply will mean exclusion from the event.

TRANSPORT SECTIONS

All Transport Sections carry a maximum speed limit of 75 km/hr. Penalties for exceeding this speed limit by more than:

0 but not more than 10 km/hr	10 points
10 " " " " 20 "	20 "
20 km/hr or more	Exclusion from the event.

Scrutiny will be held between 6.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m. on Wednesday 3rd October 1979.
