1. ENTRY

Your entry for the 1973 BP Rally is hereby accepted as (Conditional entries will be accepted in priority order to replace withdrawals. It is important that any final entry which must withdraw before the start should notify the organisers as early as possible to ensure maximum notice to the replacement conditional entry.)

2. ACCOMMODATION

There will be one extended stopover during the Event at Swan Hill in Victoria. First car will be due in at approximately 3.00 p.m. on Friday May 11 and out at approximately 10.00 a.m. on Saturday May 12. The Organisers and Sponsors will be providing sustenance in Swan Hill at the "Oasis" at approximately 3.00 p.m. Admission, which covers the cost of food only, will be free to crew members but not to officials, service crews or other attendants.

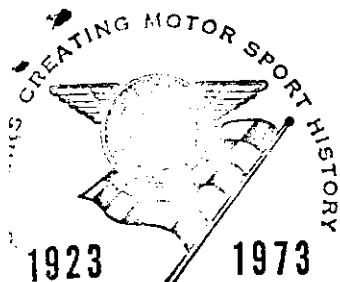
