## FINAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

### 1. STEWARDS

The Stewards of the Rally shall be Messrs. M. H. Monk and W. T. Kendall.

### 2. MAPS

The Maps required, on which are all the places referred to in the Route Instructions, are as follows. With the exception of Map 301 "100 Miles round Melbourne", which is obtainable from the Light Car Club of Australia at 5/6d. (6/- posted), they are all obtainable from -

N.B. Maps 320, 321 and 4 must be in the editions shown, i.e. the most recent maps. The whole brochure of Maps from Broadbent's will cost 31/- plus 1/2d, postage.

Maps of the routes in Tasmania and South Australia will be supplied free to entrants from Hobart and Adelaide at the start.

### 3. SIGNS

The Promoters will supply free to each entrant a Rally Sign for each front door and a number for each rear door or equivalent area. These must be smoothly affixed over a CLEAN surface.

### 4. SCRUTINEERING

The cars will be examined for roadworthiness and compliance with civil authority requirements at the following times and places:-

Melbourne Metropolitan Entrants: At the Exhibition Police Station Yard, Saturday, 27th April from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. or Sunday, 28th April from 10 a.m. to 12 Noon,

Other Victorian Entrants: At the nearest Police Station at a time to be arranged individually.

Hobart Starters: At the Start Point, immediately before the start on Tuesday, 30th April.

Adelaide Starters: At the Sporting Car Club of South Australia immediately before the Start on Wednesday, 1st May.

Goulburn Starters: To be arranged and notified individually.

Signs, numbers and "Passes OK" stickers will be supplied at scrutineering points. No car will be permitted to start without the approval of the scrutineers.

5. START

The various Start Points on the Assembly Stage, all on Wednesday 1st May, are as follows:

Ex Melbourne: From Chadstone Shopping Centre, Oakleigh. The first car will leave at 9.00 p.m., the remainder of the field following at 2 minute intervals. All cars must be present by 8.30 p.m.

Ex Goulburn: From the BP Station, Cnr. Auburn and Clinton Streets, Goulburn. First car leaves at 7.00 p.m., remainder at 2 minute intervals. All cars must be present by 6.45 p.m.

Ex Adelaide: From the Sporting Car Club of South Australia, 34 Kensington Terrace, Beulah Park. The first car leaves at 7.00 p.m. (E.S.T.) i.e. 6.30 p.m. local time. All cars must be present by 6.45 p.m. (E.S.T.) i.e. 6.15 p.m. local time.

Starters from Hobart will be separately advised, but will leave Hobart for Devonport on the afternoon of 30th April, to catch the "Princess of Tasmania". They will be met at Port Melbourne on the morning of 1st May, after which they will be free until 8.30 p.m. that day. Their cars will not be impounded.

6. AREA OF THE TRIAL STAGE

The whole of the Trial Stage of the Rally, i.e. after departure from Ballarat is bounded:

- On the North: by the River Murray
- On the West: by the longitude of Warracknabeal
- On the East: by the longitude of Lakes Entrance
- On the South: (a) West of Melbourne - by the latitude of Ballarat  
(b) East of Melbourne - by the coastline.

7. ACCOMMODATION

You are advised to make reservations for overnight bed and breakfast as follows:

- At Swan Hill, night of Thursday, 2nd May
- At Sale, night of Saturday, 4th May.

Approximate arrival times at each will be 6.00 p.m. - 9.00 p.m. on the respective days, and departures, 8.00 a.m. onwards from Swan Hill and 9.00 a.m. onwards from Sale. You will need to specify therefore, an early meal at Swan Hill on Friday, 3rd May.
