

BP RALLY OF S.E. AUSTRALIA 1967

FINAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS
and Instructions to Entrants
(in accordance with GSR 9)

ORGANISING
COMMITTEE
(GSR 3)

1. The members of the Organising Committee appointed by the Organisers shall be Messrs. C. W. Weir (Chairman), R. L. Dearie, D. Opie, R. L. Baker, and J. Gowland.

SCRUTINY
(GSR 13)

2. Cars must be presented for scrutineering as to roadworthiness at the following times and places:

S.A. Starters: at the Service division of Clem Smith Motors, 152 West Terrace, Adelaide, S.A. at 7.30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 2nd, 1967, or by arrangement with the Secretary of the Sporting Car Club of S.A.

N.S.W. Starters: at BP Yagoona S/Sta., Hume Highway, Yagoona, N.S.W., between 2 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 3rd 1967 or earlier by arrangement with the Secretary of the N.S.W. Police Motor Sports Club (Mr. W. Ford), 53 Sydney Road, Warriewood, N.S.W.

VIC. Starters: at the Exhibition police station, Bathdown Street, Carlton between 10 a.m. and 12 noon on Sunday April 30, 1967, (by members of the Victoria Police Motor Sports Club).

TAS. Starters: to be advised direct.

Failure to pass roadworthiness scrutiny (or re-scrutiny) shall necessarily involve exclusion from the Rally (GSR 12).

REGISTRATION

3. Cars will further be checked for compliance with their details of Registration at the actual starts, (see FSR 4 below), and failure of a car to comply with the registered details may involve exclusion of that car from the Rally.

START
ARRANGEMENTS
(GSR 4)

4. Cars shall report for the start of the Assembly Stage as follows:

S.A. Starters: from the clubrooms of the Sporting Car Club of South Australia, 260 Portrush Road, Beulah Park, S.A. from 4.45 pm (S.A. time) onwards on Wednesday, May 3rd. Cars must assemble no later than 4.30 p.m. (S.A. Time) on that date at the above address.

N.S.W. Starters: from the BP Yagoona Service Station, Hume Highway, Yagoona, N.S.W. from 5.15 p.m. (E.S.T.) onwards on Wednesday, May 3rd. Cars must assemble at the above address no later than 5 p.m. (E.S.T.) on that date.

VIC. Starters: from the Northland Shopping Centre, Murray Road, Preston Vic., from 8.10 p.m. (E.S.T.) onwards on Wednesday, May 3rd, 1967. Cars must assemble at the above address no later than 7.30 pm (E.S.T.) on that date.

SIGNS
(GSR 14)

5. The lettering within the area specified in GSR 14, of the name of a "trade" entrant, as shown in the relevant entry form is permitted without penalty, in addition to the names of the crew.

It is also permitted to have, on the front of the overalls or other dress of crew members, the names of such members in neat unobtrusive lettering, embroidered or otherwise.

(GSR 26)

6. The phrase "within seven days of the Start of the Rally" in GSR 26, first line, shall be interpreted to mean "within seven days prior to the Start of the Rally".

TIME
INTERVALS
(GSR 38)

7. The words "and Division" are to be inserted after the words "each Stage" in line 1 of GSR 38.

8. (i) The official maps of the Rally, to which Route and other Instructions refer, shall be as follows:-

* N.B. The required "Nagambie" map is that gridded black (statute miles) NOT that gridded purple, (metric system).

(ii) In addition to the above:

S.A. Starters will require -

- a) A useable map of the main road route from Adelaide to Pinnaroo.
- b) Broadbents Map 320c "Western Half of Victoria".

TAS. Starters will require -

- a) A useable map of main road route Hobart - Devonport, Tas.
- b) Broadbents Map 320c "Western Half of Victoria".

VIC. Starters will require -

- a) Broadbents Map 320c "Western Half of Victoria".

(iii) Other maps may be used at competitor's own risk.

10. The preamble to Appendix A, line 2, should read "(Series Production Sports Cars) and Group E (Series Production Touring Cars) of Appendix C to the National Competition Rules".

APPENDIX B

11. The words "or failure to comply with instructions or Rally signs" are to be added after the words "breach of these Regulations in line 17.
