On behalf of the North Eastern Car Club, I'm pleased to supply you with a set of Supplementary Regulations for the 1998 Kelly Country Trial.

As you may have seen from the advertisements in Australian Rallysport News, the Kelly Country Trial will be run for the first time in 1998 utilising many of the areas once traversed by our most famous bushranger, Ned Kelly.

The event will be fully navigational, but will not entail extremely difficult navigation as experienced in events such as the Olde BP Rally or the Experts Trial. Our vision for the event is to give competitors an enjoyable night's rallying on great roads, without the frustration of spending time up the wrong road.

In all we've planned around 300km total distance for the event. The selection of roads was made on the basis that the event will be run in the middle of winter, and we're confident we've chosen an all-weather course that will be in good condition no matter what the weather is like on the night. However, we can't guarantee there won't be snow on some of the higher stages, to add to the excitement.

I encourage you to enter the 1998 Kelly Country Trial. We plan this to be the first of many annual Kelly Country Trials, and I look forward to receiving your entry.
