

Minutes of ARC Executive Committee meeting held 18 June 1992 at the Cuthbert residence

Present: Glenn Cuthbert, Gary Hodgskiss, Stuart Lister, Dave McKenzie, Keith Morling.

Meeting commenced 9:10 pm

Officials. We need an enormous amount of help with officials. Other car clubs may be able to help by running one or more controls semi-independently. Gary to write to CCRMIT, CCC, FFCC, NCCA, MSCC, TCC, SCC, MUCC, CRBCC, Christian Autosports, to solicit help.

Organisational structure. Glenn presented a proposed structure chart. The proposal was modified and agreed to. Gary to type up.

A media release has been sent out.

A letter has been sent to car manufacturers (except Holden!). We have asked for the use of 10 cars during the rally. They will get extensive promotion in return.

Hilton Hotel. Our contact person has left, so we had to go over some old ground to get back up to speed. They have offered \$120 per twin room night with \$30 per extra person night. \$5 per night parking. Use of conference room has not been mentioned. Their rates for cocktail parties etc are way over the top. There is no minimum number of rooms and the rate applies to any rally credentialed person for the duration of the rally. It was decided to make a tentative booking of 100 rooms and to ask for \$20 for extra people. Discussions centred on how much to subsidise rooms for competitors, and who - the whole field or just grade threes and fours. A decision to be made later when someone has a brainwave.

Printing. We maybe able to get a cheap printing deal in Australia from Mercury Printing via Ken Ash. We would offer associate sponsorship in return.

Dave has initiated the required action to establish Victorian Rally Services as the umbrella company for the rally.

A to A timing. Nobody really understands this. There will have to be extensive training and practice by both organisers and officials. A few dummy runs will be a must. Gary to send out copy of CAMS brochure with minutes.

Healesville Council have resolved to support the event and will form a working party to co-ordinate other local activities with the rally.

Signs. A to A timing will require many more signs than special stage events. Baron Signs have offered to help. Although CAMS have sets of signs, we will make our own. Stuart has seen a plastic sign in New Zealand that may be suitable and will investigate further.

Communications. Stuart to investigate feasibility of using Telecom or Optus facilities.

Channel 10. Glenn has spoken to Channel 10 who have said they will not provide money. They will look for a production sponsor. Air time is then sold to advertisers to cover production costs. Glenn showed a video produced by Homes Glen TAFE of this year's Alpine, which although lacking in vision quality was very well edited and has been broadcast by Channel 9.
