Dear Resident,

Thank you for your co-operation with the conduct of the Healesville Stages Rally.

As previously discussed with you, the road at the front of your property will be used as part of the rally route. This road will be a **COMPETITIVE** special stage and will be closed for the times shown below.

The Rally has the approval of the Shire Council, VicRoads, Victoria Police, the Department of Conservation & Natural Resources, and other authorities whose facilities are being used. A competitive stage of a rally is a section of road along which competitors are timed over a set distance. This means that the competing vehicles will be travelling very fast past your property.

Safety has a very high priority in this event. We will have radio points every five kilometres along the special stage and an ambulance at a maximum of eight kilometre intervals as well at the stage start. Radio points at the start and finish of the stage will have communication with Rally Headquarters and the Police.

Prior to the competing vehicles, the course will be traversed by three vehicles:

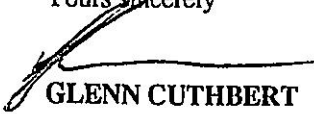
- 000 (triple zero). The 000 car will be 50 minutes ahead of the first competing vehicle and will ensure that all safety marshals, radios, etc are in position and are operational.
- 00 (double zero). The 00 car will be 20 minutes ahead of the first competing vehicle and will do a second check of the stage.
- 0 (zero). The zero car will be 10 minutes ahead of the first competing vehicle and will pass your residence with a siren sounding and flashing roof mounted lights. This car will be driven by Mr. Keith Morling who will be accompanied by Sergeant Frank Horvarth of the Victoria Police. The passage of this vehicle is the signal that the stage is ready for the first competing vehicle.

Please do not travel on the road in front of your property for any reason after the coloured tape has been placed across the entrance to your property. If there is an emergency at your household, please telephone Rally Headquarters on (059) 62 2111, the Police general emergency on 11 444, or the Healesville Police on (059) 62 4422. Contact with any of these numbers will enable us to halt the rally immediately and render assistance to you.

You may travel on the road in front of your property after the sweep car has passed and removed the coloured tape from across the entrance to your property.

This event is the Victorian round of the Australian Rally Championship, and as such the very best drivers in Australia are competing. I invite you to watch Australia's top rally drivers in action, but please do stand well back from the road and ensure that children and animals are well supervised. I sincerely thank you for your assistance and co-operation with this event.
