1. Scrutiny

Scrutineering will be held on WEDNESDAY, 24TH MARCH at *Performance Exhaust*, 49 New Street, Ringwood, (03) 9870 4977, between 6.00 pm and 9.00 pm.

Competitors are reminded that they must present their vehicles "passed" scrutineering slip to the event official when booking at the start location, otherwise route instructions will not be issued.

2. Door Panels, Numbers and Decals

Door panels and car numbers will be supplied by the organisers at the scrutineering location and at the start location. The proper displaying of door panels and car numbers are compulsory.

3. Licence Requirements

Entrants and all crew members of every competing vehicle (with the exception of service crews) must possess a current CAMS basic or superior licence, or a current CAMS Level 2 or superior licence.

4. The Start

The start will be outside the Grand Ridge Brewery, Mirboo North (see attached town map).

To get to Mirboo North, exit the Princes Highway at the intersection of Princes Highway and Strzelecki Highway just west of Morwell. This intersection is signposted "Strzelecki Highway, Mirboo North". From there follow main road (Strzelecki Highway) and Mirboo North signs.

5. Refuelling

Fuel will be available near the start at Ridgeway Motors in Mirboo North (see attached town map). Competitors are advised to refuel upon arrival in Mirboo North as the service station closes at 7 p.m..

Fuel **will not be available** from a commercial outlet during the event.

Crews with vehicles that are unable to complete the entire event without refuelling will be able to deposit their own fuel container (clearly labelled with crew name and car number) with an official at the start, who will deliver them to a location along the route, which will be advised in the crew briefing prior to the start of the event

7. Odometer Check

1. Travelling eastward along the Princes Highway, approximately 1.64 kms east of the traffic lights in Yarragon (near Roberts Road) the T45 sign to the green and white 'Trafalgar' sign on the western side of Trafalgar (just before the 80 km/h sign) measured 4.89 kms.

2. Travelling eastward along the Princes Highway through Moe:

T30 to T25 = 4.02 kms

T25 to T20 = 5.59 kms

T20 to 146 (white post) = 3.38 kms

3. Travelling south along the Strzelecki Highway from the Princes Highway, the B460 green sign (Thorpdale 21, Mirboo North 33, Leongatha 56 and Inverloch 83) to a power pole with an Amiets Road sign measured 4.52 kms.

8. Maps

Tarra Valley Edition 1 - 1:50,000 (Recreation Survey Maps) April 1998 must be supplied by competitors. Other maps will be supplied by the organisers.

9. Grid References

These will be used extensively on both 1:50,000 and supplied 1:25,000 maps. Make sure you have a Rally Romer with both metric scales.

10. Servicing

No time or location has been provided for car servicing.

11. Late Time

Total late time shall be 120 minutes.

12. Briefing

A crew briefing will be conducted at approximately 7.30 p.m.

13. Finish

The event will conclude at the Mirboo North Cricket Club Rooms, Mirboo North Recreation Reserve, with the first car expected at midnight. Refreshments for competitors, supporters, officials and spectators will be available at the finish.
